My airport city game

Long airport layovers are usually associated with expensive Wi-Fi, reheated sandwiches, and people crowded on uncomfortable metal chairs. But these eight airports have turned this whole idea on its head, offering mini city tours so travelers can make the most of their time between flights and tick another box out of their places I want to visit list in one fell swoop. In other words? A seven-hour layover has never looked so appealing. August 18, 2016If you have at least an eight-hour layover in Taipei, you can participate in one of two free city tours organized by the airport. Tour A ferries guests to the beautiful Zushih Temple, about 14 miles outside the city, and on a trip to shop for pottery; Tour B packs in faster stops to some of Taiwan's most famous sites, including Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall and Taipei 101, the country's tallest building. How to book it: Sign up for the tourist service centre in the arrivals hall. Tours are on a first come, first served basis and are offered twice a day (8:15 a.m. and 1:45 a.m.). Singapore's Changi airport has so many cool features (a butterfly garden, a video gaming room, free massage chairs) that we wouldn't blame you for not wanting to leave its air-conditioned comfort. If you do, however, Singapore offers two free city tours for people traveling through the airport that have six or more hours to go by- City Sights tour hits all downtown highlights like Merlion and Gardens By the Bay, while the Heritage Tour focuses on exploring cool neighborhoods like Little India and Kampong Glam.How to book it: Instead of clearing immigration , go to either Transfer Lounge F in Terminal 2 or Transfer Lounge A in Terminal 3. There are four heritage and two city sights tours by day-Heritages are during the morning and afternoon, and city sights in the evening (it's all about the sunset skyline). Tickets are first come, first served. As a major layover point for transcontinental U.S. flights, Salt Lake City's airport gets a lot of people with layovers. An opportunity? Anyone with a more than two-hour layover can get a free tour of the Temple Square area of downtown SLC courtesy of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. If you want to skip the temple itself, it's an easy walk to attractions like City Creek Park and the Utah Museum of Contemporary Art. (Want to take ski lessons? You'll have to stay a little longer.) How to book it: Head over to one of the two information desks and get a brochure for today's pick-up and drop-off schedule. A desk agent can show you where to catch the shuttle. Istanbul's Ataturk Airport is at a crossroads between Europe and Asia and is one of the world's busiest. If you have more than six hours between flights there, you can sign up for the free touristanbul program, which gives travelers a short tour of the city and some of its most iconic landmarks, including Hippodrome Square, the Blue Mosque and Topkapi Palace.How to book it: When you look for the Hotel Desk in the arrivals hall. (It's next to Starbucks.) There you can sign up for one of the five daily tour departures, but you must be there at least half an hour before the next one starts. Layover deals at Tokyo's Narita Airport are divided into two basic groups: sightseeing and shopping. If you choose to go out with a guide on a cultural tour, you can explore the cities of Tako or Shibayama, go on a forest hike, or visit the Museum of Aeronautical Sciences; on-your-own travelers can shop at one of two shopping malls that are accessible from the airport via train. The only potential holdup? Make sure your suitcase can still contain all the items you bought during your stopover. How to book it: The airport takes these programs so seriously that there is a dedicated desk just to organize tours. It is called Narita Transit Program Counter, and is in Terminal 1F in central building. While some airports require you to have longer layovers if you want to join a tour, Seoul's Incheon Airport has tour options for as little as an hour, meaning there is a swarm of options. Travelers can spend from one to five hours on either a temple-focused or city-focused tour with English-speaking guides, all provided for free. And if you've ever dreamed of getting an insider's ride at the airport itself, now's your chance. How to book it: Depending on which one is closer, go to either the desk between gates 25 and 29 or the Hana Tour desk at gate 8.Don't expect your Amsterdam airport layover to include a sightseeing tour by bus. Instead, if you fly national carrier KLM and have a layover of six hours or more, you can sign up for the airline's layover with a local program. Fill out a quick questionnaire about your interests (fashion, food, tech, etc.) and KLM will pair you with an English-speaking local with similar likes, give you free bus tickets to the city and back to the airport, and pay for the first round of drinks when you meet your new friend at a bar in central Amsterdam.How to book it: Once you've booked a KLM itinerary that includes an Amsterdam layover, you should get an automated email from the airline asking if you want to sign up for the program. Flying Qatar Airways? If you have at least six hours to go between flights, the national airline has free tours of Doha, which hit major attractions like I.M. Pei and the Jean-Michel Wilmotte-designed Museum of Islamic Art, Souk Watif (hello, last minute souvenir shopping), and the Katara Cultural Village. The trips come with a free visa, which means it won't be hassled to get back to the airport later, and perhaps more importantly, a free bottle of water - in case you forgot you were in the desert. How to book it: Make a beeline to the Doha City Tour desk, located in concourse B next to the Montblanc store. With safety considerations, packing, transportation and everything else that comes along with it, air travel is a very hectic Keys, cell phone, wallet, wallet... it's pretty right to misplace something at the airport or leave an item on the plane. If you've lost something while flying in or out of Oklahoma City, here's information about Lost and Found at Will Rogers World Airport. First, it's important to understand that unlike many airports around the country, there really isn't a central Lost and Found department or counter at the airport in Oklahoma City. Instead, it depends on where you left your misplaced item. If you don't know where you lost it, contact them all. In the terminal: For items left in and around the airport terminal itself, perhaps in a seating area or near baggage requirements, contact the Will Rogers World Airport Police Department. Regular airport office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.At a security checkpoint: If you lost something at the security checkpoint, it will be handed over to the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), the U.S. agency in charge of airport security and a separate unit from the airport itself. You may also want to contact the TSA if an item is missing from checked baggage. On the plane: Everything left on a plane will be handled by the specific airline. You can inquire about a lost item either at the airport ticket counter or by phone. Will Rogers currently services flights with Alaska, Allegiant, American, Delta, United, and Southwest in a rental car. Likewise, contact each company if you have lost something in a car rented from one of The Will Rogers World Airport kiosks. There are currently eight rental companies with airport service: Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Enterprise, Hertz, National, and Thrift. Get the detailed contact information for each. When it comes to lost items, keep in mind it can take a few days for them to be found or handed over. Then contact the relevant company or entity several times. Some may take your contact information and get back to you if the item shows up. There may also be a limit to how long an item is stored. That's why you don't have to wait. Get in touch with the above contact as soon as you notice something missing. Thanks for letting us know! It's not the most exciting part of planning a trip, but the decision on how best to get from the airport to your accommodation (and back again) is usually a detail worth researching. Fortunately, transport to and from Amsterdam Schiphol Airport is relatively easy, fast and can be cheap. Find out in advance if it makes the most sense for you to take a bus, train or car, as each mode of transport has its own pros and cons based on your individual journey. The train is the cheapest and fastest way to get to the city centre, shuttling passengers to Amsterdam Centraal Station in 15 minutes. Although the bus takes longer, it has several stops throughout the city, so depending on where your hotel is, it could be a more convenient option. Taxis are the solution, and the airport bus can also take you to your door at a much lower price. Trains: 15 minutes, from \$5Bus: 30 minutes, from \$7Taxi: 20 minutes, from \$50Hotel Shuttle: 30 minutes, from \$20 (for single rider) 01 of 05 The train from Schiphol Airport to Amsterdam Centraal Station is the fastest and cheapest route to the city center. The train runs 24 hours a day, with departures scheduled for every 10-15 minutes between 6am.m. and 1a.m.(they depart every hour at other times). The trip takes just 15 minutes, leaving passengers in one of Amsterdam's most central and best connected locations. Tickets are only 4.50 euros, or about \$5, and you can buy them at the ticket counter at arrival level or at the yellow machines using euro coins or a credit card. To catch the train, go down a level to the floor under the ticket machines. The train is one of the best ways to get into the city, and avoids any risk of getting stuck in busy Amsterdam traffic. However, you must continue your trip from the train station after arrival, either by foot, tram, bus or taxi, which can be a hassle, especially if you are carrying lots of luggage. Tip: Especially if you plan to arrive after 12 a.m. or on weekends, check the NS (Dutch Railways) website to see if any maintenance work will interrupt your journey. 02 of 05 Amsterdam Airport Express, or Bus 397, departs from the airport several times per hour between 5 a.m and 12:30 a.m. You can catch this great red bus just outside the main airport hall, and the tour takes about 30 minutes to arrive in central Amsterdam. The bus doesn't go to Amsterdam Centraal Station, but it has stops near Olympic Stadium, Museumplein and Leidseplein, so it can be an even more convenient option for travelers with accommodation near these popular areas. Check the address of your lodging or ask before arrival to see if the bus is the best option for you. 03 of 05 RUBEN RAMOS/Getty Images You'll find plenty of private taxis to rent in the taxi line just outside the main entrance to the arrivals and train station level at Schiphol Airport. Be sure to choose a taxi from this line and not from individuals who are walking around requesting their services. Note that taxis run on a strict meter basis and there is no fixed airport rate. Uber is also available from Amsterdam airport, and you can choose standard UberX, a luxury Uber Black or a van for a larger group of people. UberX is sometimes a little cheaper than standard taxis, but you'll need internet on your phone to call Uber. Although it is much more convenient to get a car directly to your hotel, traffic can cause severe delays and drive up the meter. If you want door-to-door service, airport transfers can be a more affordable option. 04 of 05 The Schiphol Hotel Shuttle, operated by Connexion, offers service to more than 100 Amsterdam hotels. Shuttles run every 30 minutes between 6 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. from platform A7, just outside the main entrance to and trains Level. The bus is a shared vehicle that can accommodate up to eight passengers, so the total travel time varies depending on the number of stops. If you are the last fell out, then the total travel time can be significantly higher. The price of the shuttle starts at about \$20 per person, but if you're traveling with a family or group, then there are discounts for each additional traveler. For example, a large family will save money by using the shuttle instead of renting two separate taxis. Buy tickets at the Connexion service desk upon arrivals 4 (opposite Starbucks), or online. Be sure to ask your hotel first if they offer a free airport transfer before booking the Connexion shuttle. A cruise through the canals is one of the best ways to get a ride in the city, or hop on a bike and make your own tour of this uber-bike-friendly capital city. The infamous red-light district and the deceptively named coffeeshops are an exciting part of Amsterdam culture to experience for foreigners, but remember they are aimed at tourists. For a more authentic cultural experience, try one of the city's prestigious museums, such as the Rijksmuseum, the Van Gogh Museum or the Anne Frank House. House.
